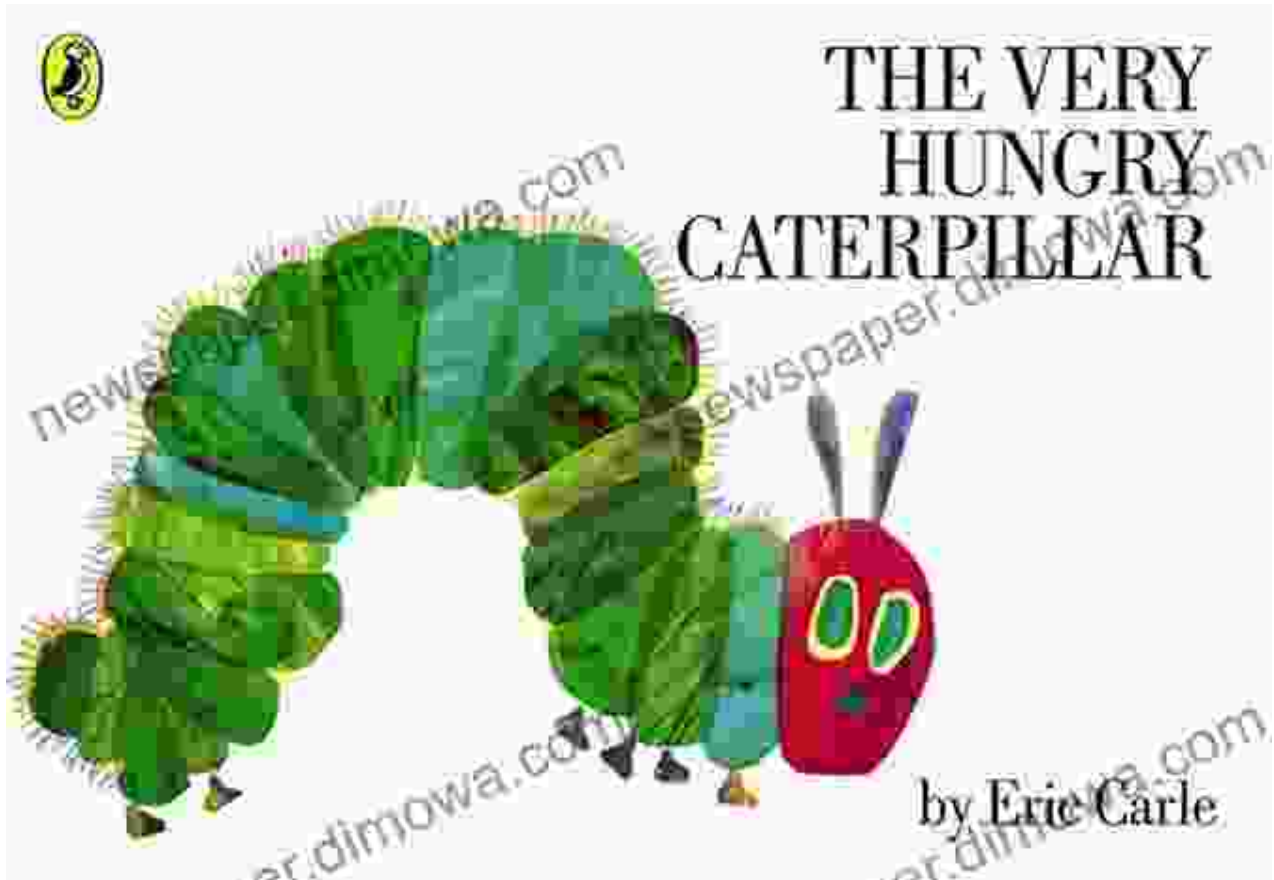

1. **The Very Hungry Caterpillar by Eric Carle**

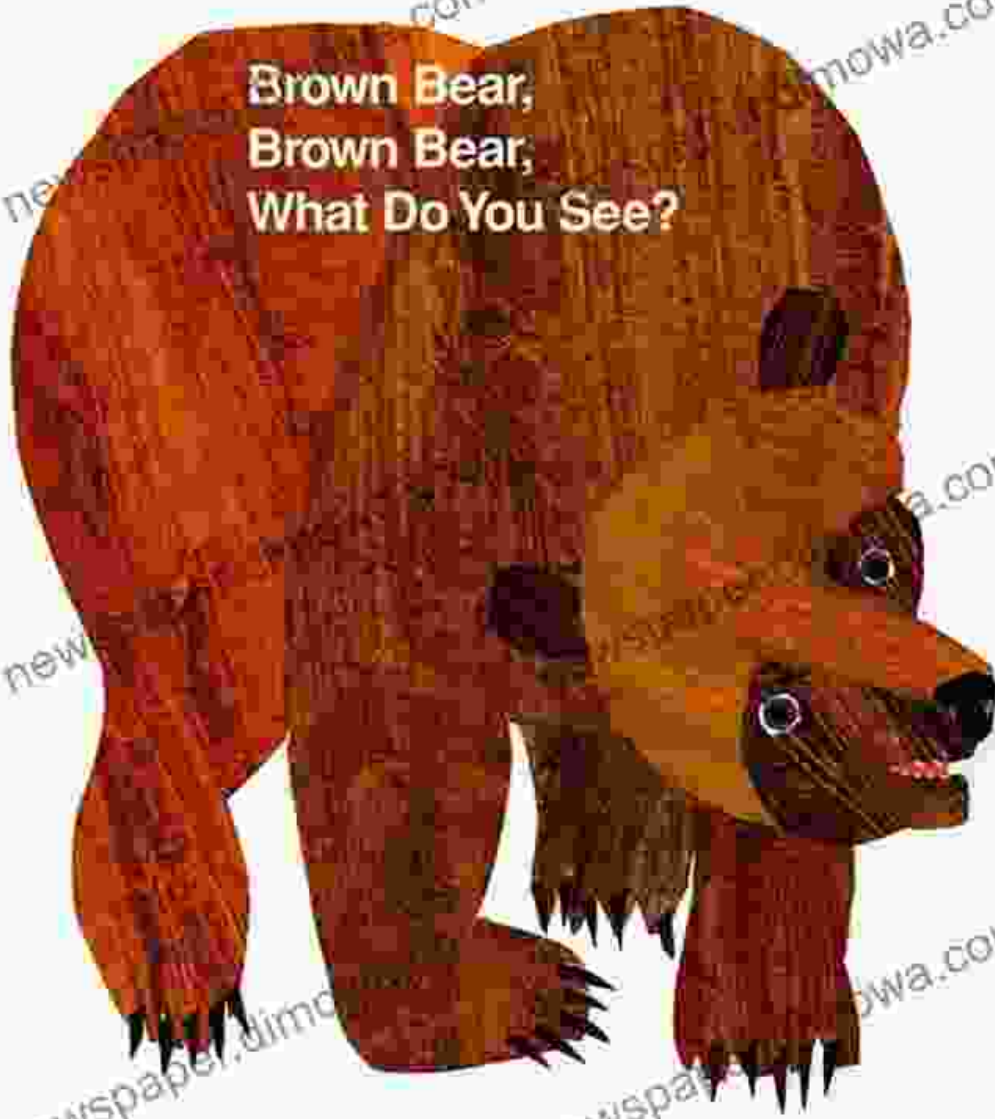

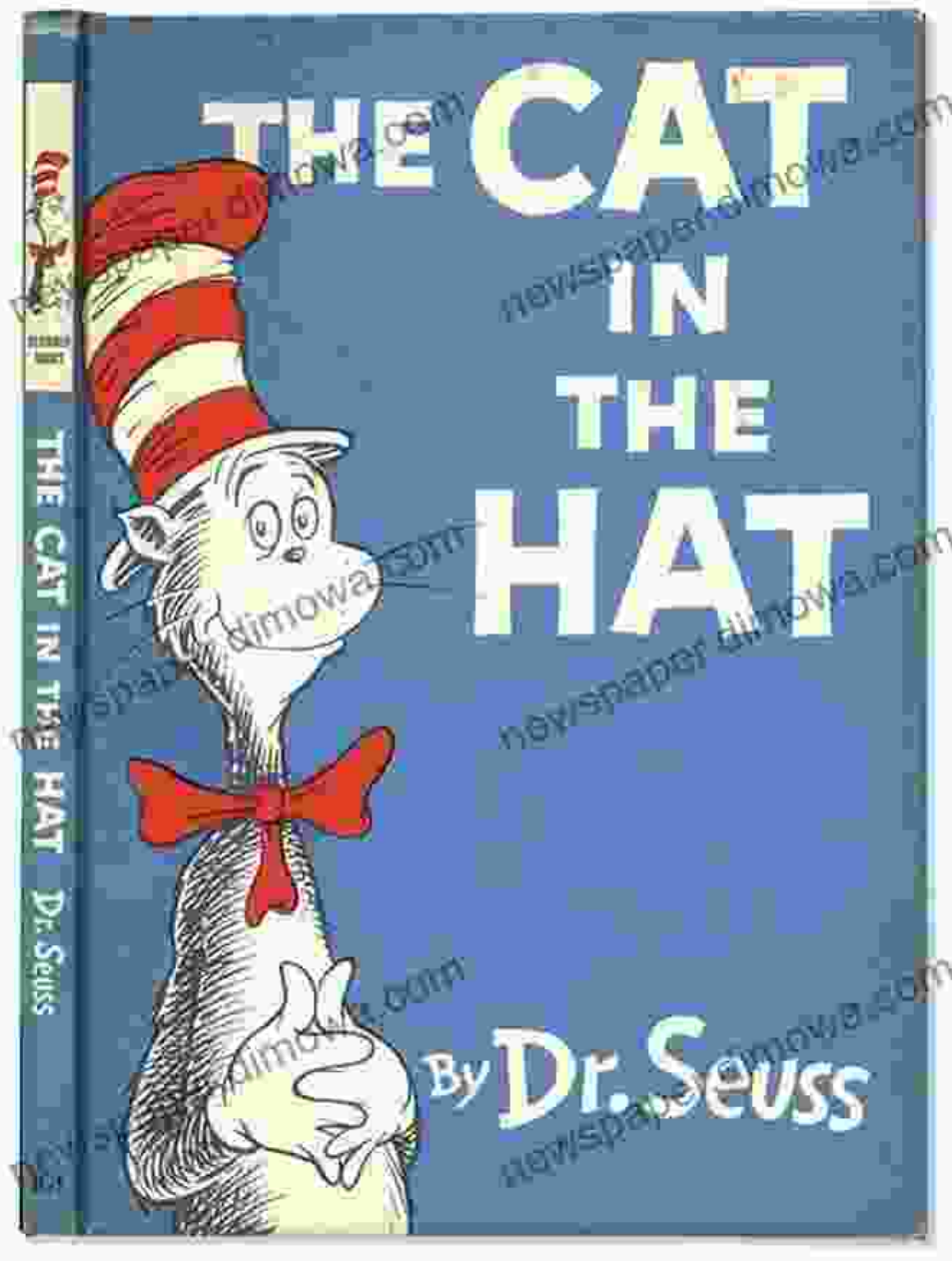

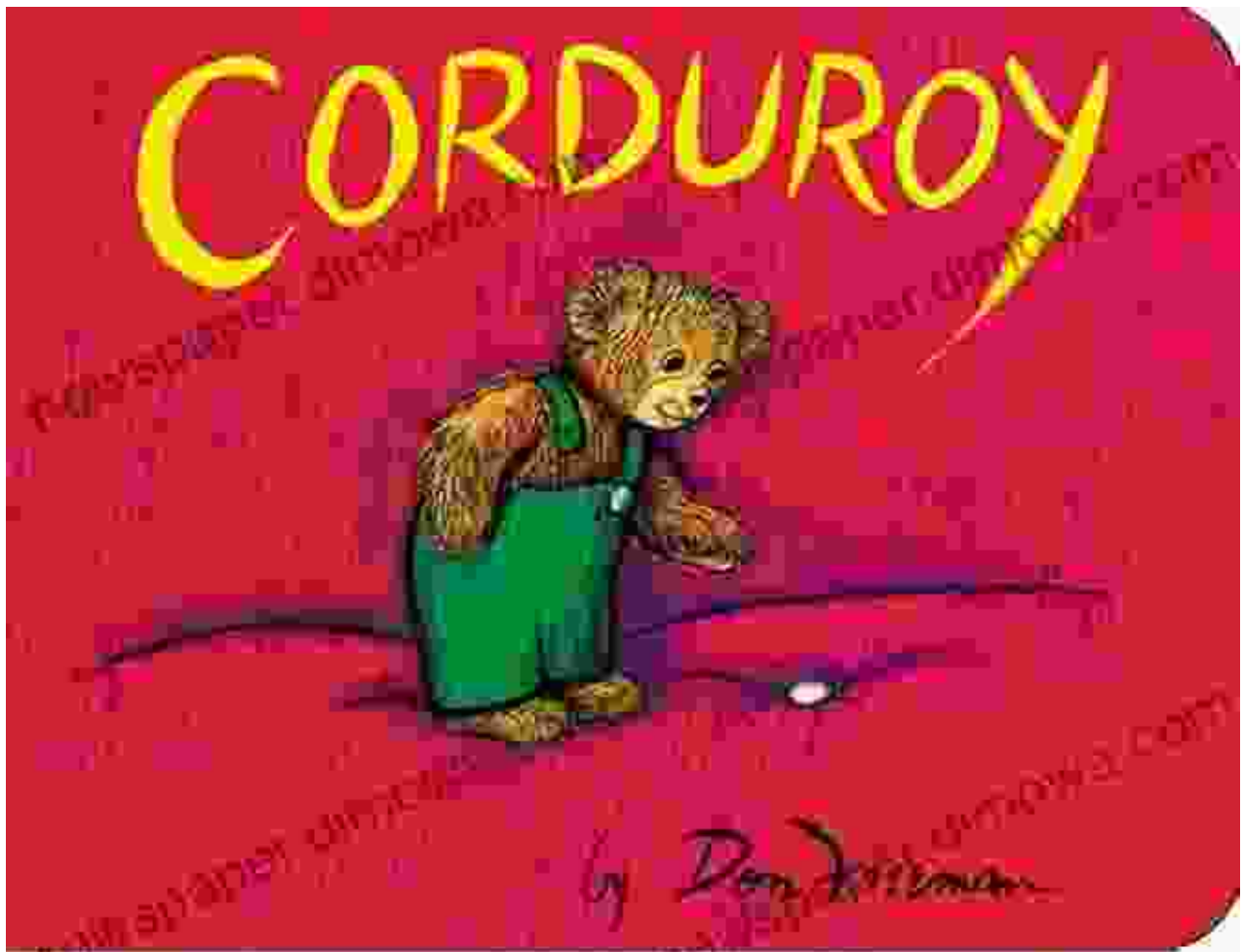
This interactive book is a great way to teach your child about colors, animals, and prepositions. And the simple, repetitive text is perfect for little ones who are just starting to learn to read.

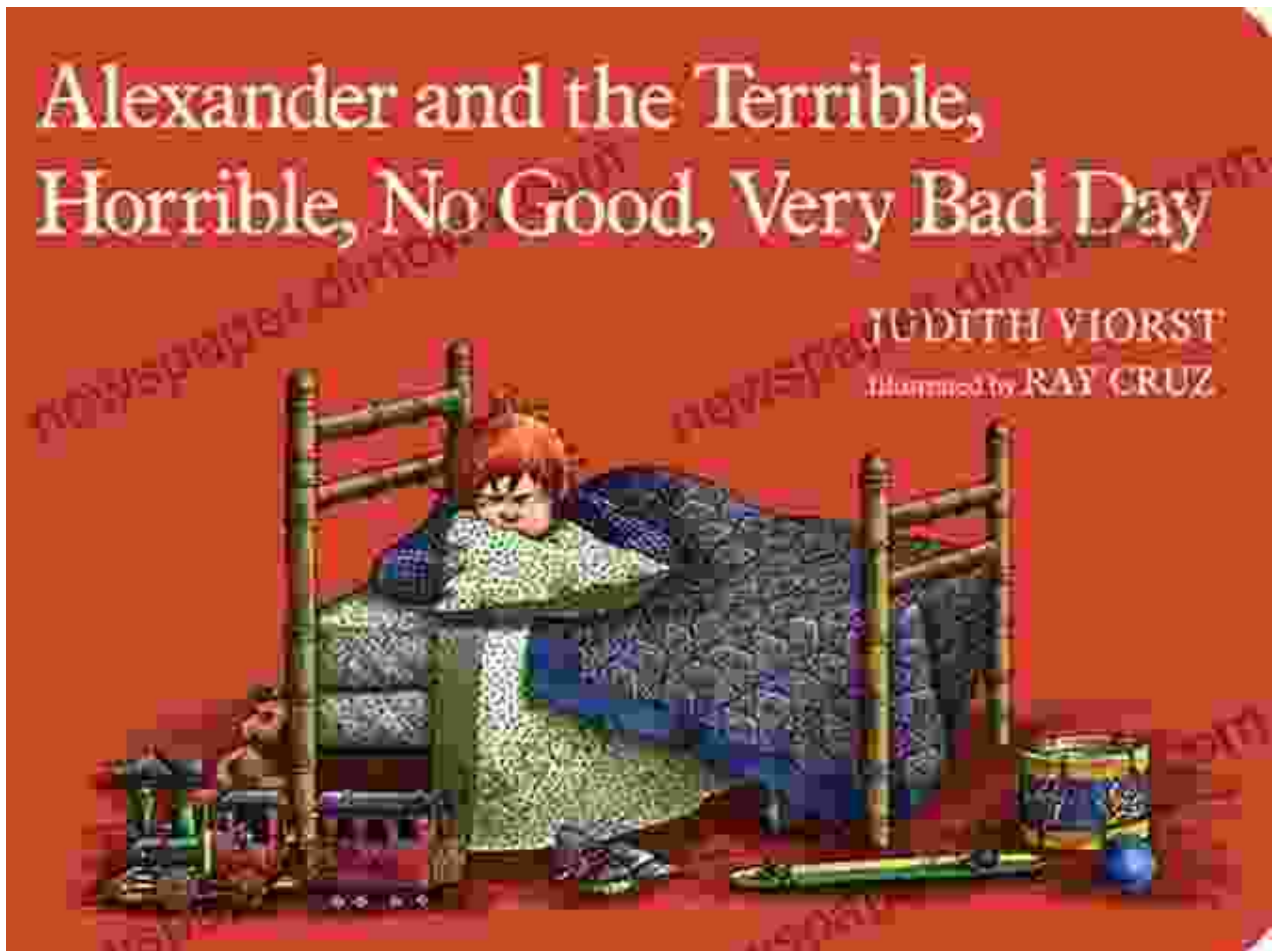

6. **The Giving Tree by Shel Silverstein**



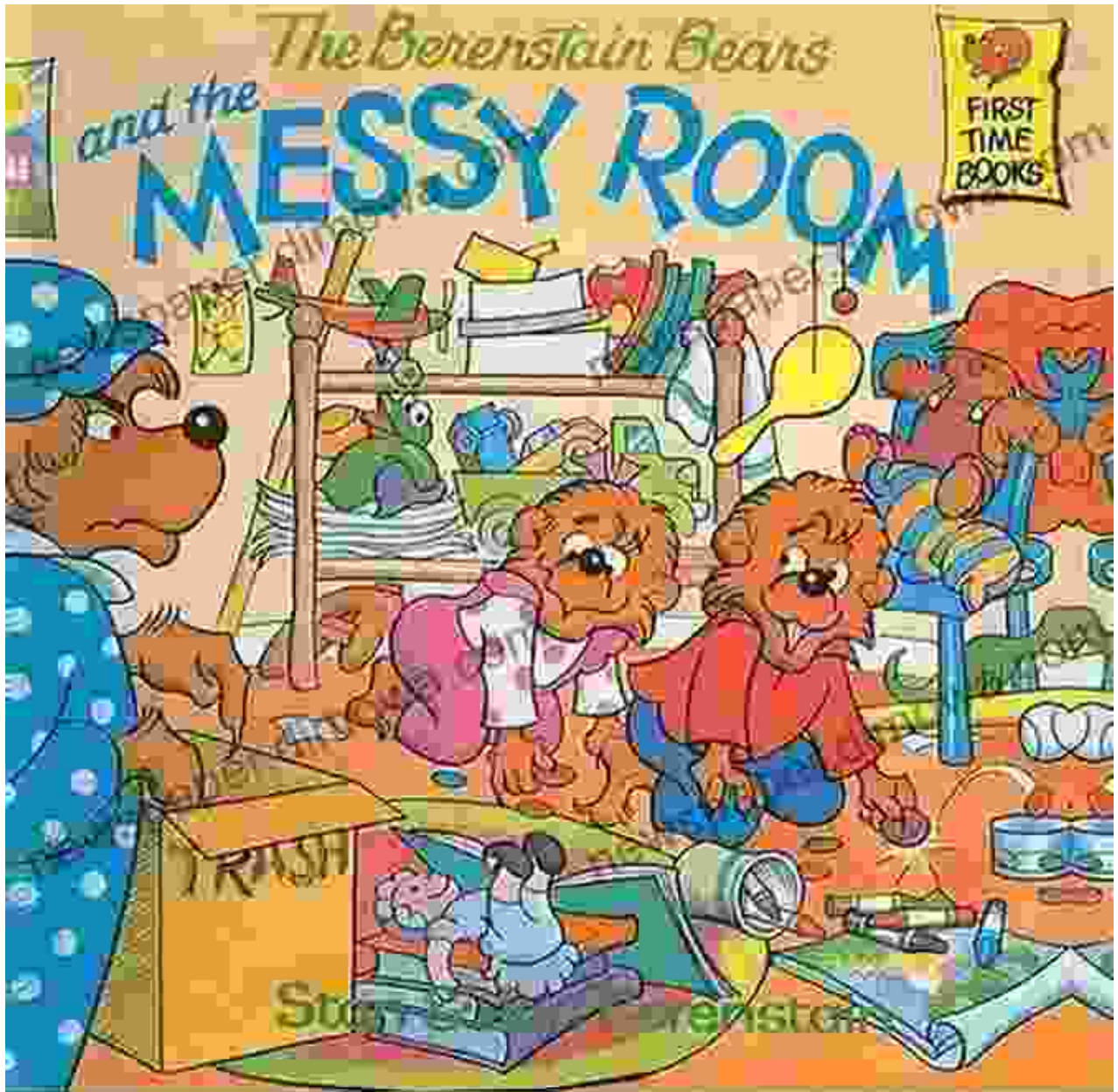

7. **Alexander and the Terrible, Horrible, No Good, Very Bad Day by Judith Viorst**



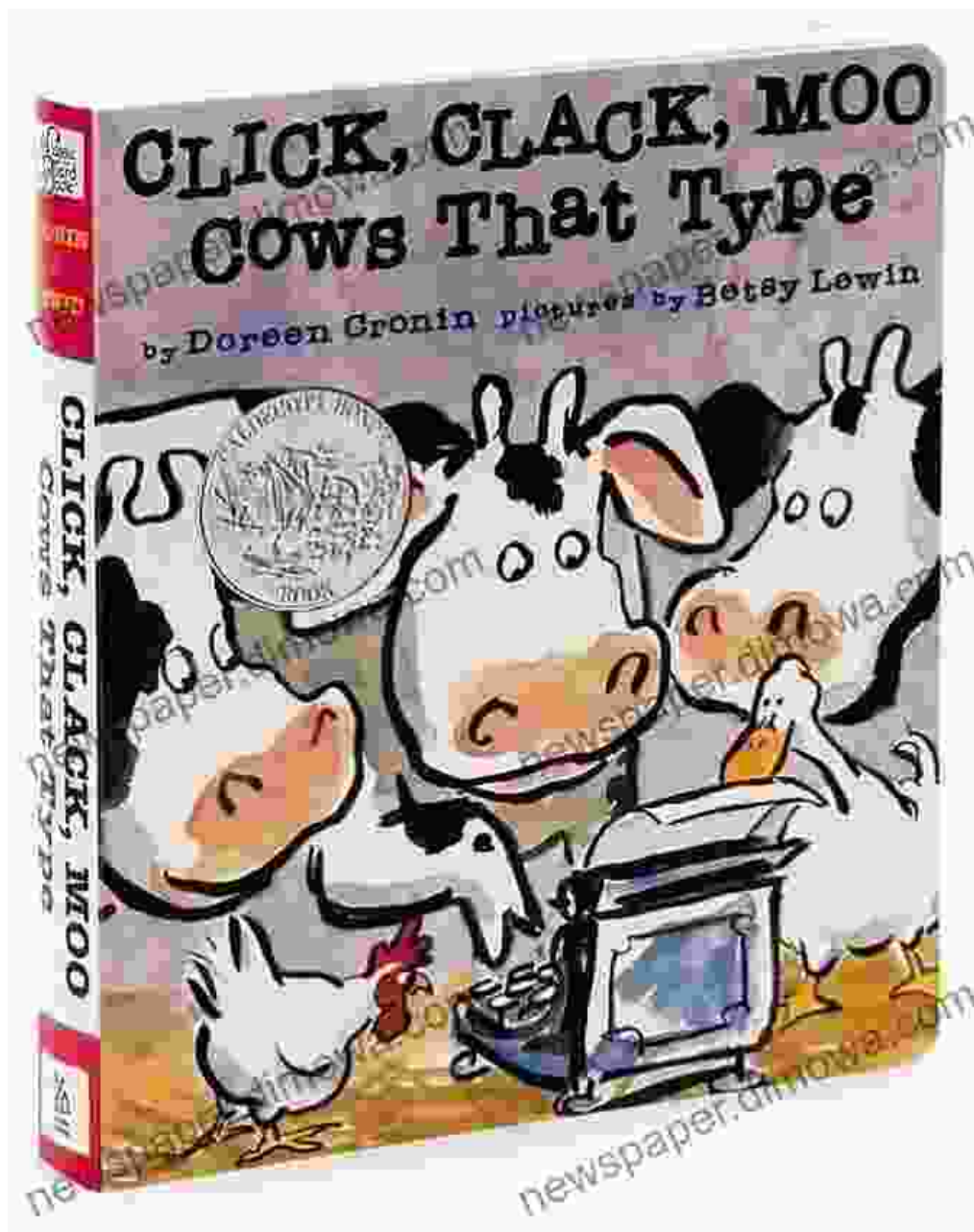
