

TALK ABOUT IT

- **TELLING STORIES** Stories are powerful ways to connect with family, friends, and neighbors. Share your own story of how climate change has affected you.
- **CONNECTION** Share the language of climate change with your friends and family.
- **IALOGUE** Ask questions—no matter where you are, there are people who are interested in learning about climate change.
- **OPTIMISM** Get your optimism, success, and hope from the many individuals and communities that are taking action.


